I offer **consultancy, evaluation, facilitation** and **mediation** services. I have been self-employed for eight years and established a limited company in 2004. Previous employment includes leading the development of nationwide consultancy services for Centrepoint, offering housing rights advice, community psychiatric nursing and performing in interactive drama-based workshops.

Consultancies have included

- helping to develop strategy in fields such as teenage pregnancy, supported housing and drug treatment,
- advising on social policy,
- identifying need and ways of meeting need for client groups such as those labelled with a dual diagnosis and older people with learning disabilities,
- helping to co-ordinate bids,
- designing services such as floating support,
- advising on organisational reviews,
- helping to implement strategy by commissioning substance misuse services and managing a professional development programme for a government agency.

Evaluation work has included

- services to homeless young people,
- a national consultation exercise
- multi-media and music technology courses for marginalised young people,
- a drug treatment service and youth work linked to the Street Crime Initiative,
- a project to widen theatre and gallery attendance,
- a support service for high risk offenders,
- estate based regeneration, capacity building and early intervention initiatives.

Facilitation and **Mediation** work includes group work supervision, action planning events, organisational reviews, training and team building days for over 90 different clients including regional government bodies, local authorities, housing associations, inter-agency forums, consortia, national and local charities. Events are tailored to the needs of the client based on careful discussion and planning. Methods and approaches range from quietly holding a space for a conversation to take place to relatively energetic exercises involving the use of drama and the creative arts.

Performance based work includes working with Spanner Workshops and Progress Theatre to explore communication skills and institutional culture in the health service, training for social care professionals with Activate Theatre and membership of Crossover intergenerational dance company.

I am a Registered Mental Nurse and BA (Hons) in English and Drama. I am a graduate of Common Purpose (1998), a member of the OXFAM Assembly (1994), chair of Connection, The Floating Support Team, vice chair of Pegasus Theatre Trust, an Associate of Thames Valley Partnership and a Red Kite Partner.
